

## Minimum Kiteboarding/Snowkiting School Requirements For PASA School Certification

\*\*To qualify for Insurance through the PASA affiliated carrier, you must be a current PASA member as well as PASA Certified.

- S Complete an Instructor Certification Program through PASA
- 5 Join PASA as a professional member and maintain current membership.
- Have only current PASA certified instructors on staff.
- **5** Utilize PASA recognized teaching standards in school.
- ▶ Utilize appropriate support materials such as current textbooks, written tests, and video materials.
- Only use a well-maintained and safe training site. Training site must be clearly marked identifying it as a training site to caution those entering the site.
- You must inspect all equipment on a regular basis and at the minimum keep a monthly log recording the inspections. Records need to be signed by the PASA certified instructor saying the equipment is safe for instructional use.
- Comply with all appropriate regulations, including maintaining a business license, and appropriate sports liability insurance.
- Have an established emergency protocol and advanced emergency communication equipment on site such as a cell phone.
- Keep regular student records and turn in applicable records to PASA.
- **5** Demonstrate and maintain a safe teaching record.
- Solution Recommended that an advanced instructor be on staff when appropriate.
- **5** Utilize an approved instruction site that allows safe instruction.

**Water specific**: utilize a water craft for emergency retrieval and/or instruction.

Never teach in or near stormy weather, lightening, excessive winds or in strong gusty conditions. Come in well in advance of storm clouds as sudden very strong and damaging gusts can come on without further warning. Avoid gust variances in excess of 15mph!



Must fill out an incident report for every incident and submit a copy to PASA. Must have a First Aid kit on site.
